## ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

English is the language of instruction at the locations. Applicants whose native language is not English will take the college's English Placement Test (EPT). Applicants who have passed either the TOEFL examination with a minimum score of 550, (Paper-Based Total) or 213 (Computer-Based Total), English as a First Language, English Language GCSE (or GCE) 'O' level with Grade 'C' and above or ELTS with a score of 6.5 and above, are exempt from the EPT, provided they have submitted original or attested results. English is not a requirement for admission. Candidates whose English proficiency is not up to the university's standard will take special English language classes.

## Admission Requirements

The applicant is required to submit the following items:

### 1. The Application Form

Fill in this form and submit it with the consultancy fee found on the agreement.

### 2. Academic Records

a) For Undergraduate Students. Enclose high school leaving diploma and final grade marksheet attested by the awarding institution or the Ministry of Education. Where necessary, these academic records and examination results must be translated into English.

b) For Graduate Students. Enclose a copy of your Bachelor's Degree and official transcripts in English attested by the awarding institution or the Ministry of Education. In addition, applicants must submit two letters of recommendation and proof of work experience.

### 3. Transfer Students

Students who have started their college/university education elsewhere and wish to apply for admission as transfer students, must submit official transcripts (marksheet) and course descriptions or syllabi in English for all work previously completed. Attestations must be made by the awarding institution.
